- □ Social Security card for each taxpayer and any dependents on the return. A Social Security benefit statement (SSA-1099), for those receiving social security payments, is a valid substitute. If you don't have a Social Security number an unexpired ITIN (Individual Taxpayer Identification Number) is required; volunteers can explain how to apply for an ITIN.
- ☐ Checkbook or pre-printed direct deposit information showing routing number and direct deposit account number if you want to authorize a direct deposit of any refund.
- ☐ All tax and income documents for 2023 (W-2 forms, Form 1095-A for anyone in the household insured through the WA HealthPlan Marketplace, interest and dividend statements, etc.)
- ☐ Date of birth for each person listed on the return.
